

Rule Suggestions for Fair Book

- **Code of Conduct:**
 - 4-H Members Code of Conduct applies to Parents, Spectators, Fitters, Ect.
- **Fair Board Member:**
 - Rules broken by Fair Board Members have consequences
- **Goat**
 - **Horns:**
 - Remove the horn length rule
OR
 - Horn rule to be amended: horns on all market wethers and does to be blunted to diameter of tip of horn to no less than dime size. If during fair weigh-in horns are found to not meet requirement, animal will be weighed and given 30 minutes to correct the issue to the satisfaction of the goat superintendent. No secondary weigh-in will occur at time of approval.
 - **Birthdates on goats:**
 - Birthday for all market wethers and doelings will be November 1st or after of the previous year
 - **Goat Weights:**
 - The change of the minimum and maximum weights, in order to deliver a true market animal to buyers and have members declare their weights.
 - Minimal weight for all market wethers and doelings will be 60 lbs at time of Fair weigh in. All animals not meeting minimal weight will be allowed to be shown in showmanship classes if already entered as well as a prospect show but will not be eligible for auction at the conclusion of the Fair
 - **Goat Class**
 - The addition of a wether dam class to be added to the show. Wether dam will be doelings of same age and weight requirements as market wethers and does but considered only as breeding stock and not a terminal project. These does will not be eligible for livestock auction. Does entered as wether dams cannot be entered in market classes and does entered in market classes will not be eligible for wether dam classes. This is a program and class designed to encourage young exhibitors to begin and develop their own breeding program
- **All Livestock Ages**
 - Match the State Fair rules regarding animal ages
 - Colorado State Fair age rules for livestock:
 - **GOATS** - Market Goats must be carrying all milk teeth in normal positions. Goats showing either or both of the first pair of permanent incisors will be disqualified. The CSF retains the right to check teeth on Market Goats. Any such mouthing of animals will be conducted upon exiting the show ring.
 - **SHEEP** - Market Lambs must be carrying all milk teeth (have lamb teeth) in place. Superintendents have the right to mouth any lamb that is suspected of not having all required teeth.
 - **BEEF** - No steer or heifer born before January of the previous year is eligible to show. The dentition process may determine age. All animals must have both temporary central incisors (baby teeth) in place. Any evidence of tampering with tooth development will be cause for disqualification. The dentitions' decision is final.
 - **SWINE** - Nothing regarding age is listed.
- **Checking out pens:**
 - Have a designated person to check out pens and adopt the Jackpot Style for this.
- **Horse Rules:**
 - Only require 3 of the 4 events in order to be in the running for the Highpoints.
- **Supreme Rabbits and Poultry**

- Have a Supreme winner for these species
- **Poultry:**
 - Extending age of meat birds to 20 weeks
 - Add Hatching at Home class
- **Rabbits:**
 - Change verbiage in rule book, #4 and #7
 - Omit a fur class that they don't have
- **Dogs:**
 - Secondary Rule Books to Contestants
 - PG 47
 - Single Wrap Pole right or left
 - Double wrap pole fig 8
 - Remove obedience from obedience rally and add classes 1-15
